#### Key Stage 2 Art Statutory Coverage

Pupils should be taught to:

1. Develop techniques, including control and use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.
2. Create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas.
3. Improve mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials (for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay)

4. Learn about great artists, architects and designers in history.	Begin to adapt the different ideas and techniques used by artists, architects and designers in their own pieces of work.
