Key Stage 2 MFL Statutory Coverage

Pupils should be taught to:

1. Listen and engage
2. Ask and answer questions
3. Speak in sentences using familiar vocabulary
4. Develop appropriate pronunciation
5. Show understanding of words and phrases
6. Write phrases from memory
7. Understand basic grammar
8. Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes
9. Broaden vocabulary

Key Objective	Key Skills
1. Speaking and Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listen beyond a level at which they can speak independently. - Tell the time in simple terms. - Articulate clearly. - Get meaning across, sometimes using phrases. - Discuss word meanings, linking to patterns in English and new language. - Use number to and beyond 100. - Use known phrases to ask and answer questions. - Create oral sentences independently.
2. Reading and Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fill in a table of verbs. - Underline correct/ incorrect. - Identify simple errors. - Memorise and recall key words to use in writing. - Sequence sentences to form short narratives. - Check that simple text makes sense and discuss understanding of the meaning.
