

Kells Lane Primary School Sports Premium Plan 2017-18

This year, the school will receive approximately £19,540 to invest in additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport that we offer, as well as promoting healthy and active lifestyles across the school. Included in this will also be travel costs to and from sporting events as well as coaching and clubs.

Ofsted have stated there are five key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across. The areas of focus are: the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity; the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement; increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport; broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils and increased participation in competitive sport.
