Key Stage 2 MFL Statutory Coverage

Speaking and Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Follow instructions when performing.- Listen to simple phrases with growing understanding.- Use basic key vocabulary and build on this through listening, practice, trial, and error.- Acquire simple vocabulary for some verbs, not always in tense.- Recall simple phrases.- Count to ten independently.
2. Reading and Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Make lists and memorise information.- Name and label articles.
