<p>How we spent our allocated amount to address barriers</p>	<p>In class learning support from teaching assistants. This is an inclusive approach that targets individual support and enables pupils to ask questions and make better progress during lessons.</p> <p>1:1 intervention planned by teachers and delivered by HLTAs (higher level teaching assistants) dependent on individual needs including reading, spelling and handwriting intervention.</p> <p>Investment into upper KS2 reading books for children, linked to their own interests in order to promote reading for pleasure, developing fluency and comprehension skills.</p> <p>Interpreter for EAL children – for children and parents to access school life and open lines of communication.</p> <p>Attendance awards and incentives to raise attendance across school.</p> <p>School counselling service to support children’s emotional needs.</p> <p>Additional maths intervention from a maths specialist teacher.</p> <p>Investment in Doodle maths and English online learning programme across the school.</p> <p>CPG workbooks provided for home learning during the summer holidays</p>
