I am delighted to be writing to you about a return to school for all children on Monday 8th March. Please see below for important information, including staggered drop off and pick up times. These have changed slightly since December.

Staggered drop off times:

8.30am – 8.45am Pupils in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

8.45am – 9.00am Pupils in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

Please note: If you have children in different year groups, all can be dropped off at the same time

Staggered pick up times:

2.50pm – 3.00pm Pupils in Nursery and Reception

3.00pm – 3.10pm Pupils in Year 1 and Year 2

3.10pm – 3.20pm Pupils in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

Additional Important Information

- We respectfully ask that parents do not gather in groups at the school entrance, exit or on the school playground.
- Only one adult per family can drop off or pick up. Any other visits to school are strictly by appointment only. You can contact the school office at KellsLane@klps.org.uk or by telephone at 0191 433 4140.
- Please continue to follow the one-way system in place and please wear a face covering on the school site.
- In line with government guidance, children will be required to wear their school uniform and should not bring any non-essential items into school. School bags, lunch boxes and water bottles are permitted.
- Children will remain in their year group bubbles. Break times and lunch times will be staggered to avoid mixing between bubbles.
- Children will return to formal PE lessons from w/b 15th March. This means they will need to come to school wearing their PE kit on designated days (see below).
